The PRIME Program consists of three outreach initiatives: The PRIME Program at Academy@Palumbo, The PRIME Program Internship, and The PRIME Program Scholarship.

The PRIME Program at Academy@Palumbo

The PRIME Program partners with Invest in Girls, and a Philadelphia public high school to teach a three- year curriculum focusing on budgeting and personal finance (Sophomore year), investing (Junior year), and college debt, interviewing, and philanthropic giving (Senior year).

The PRIME Program Internship

The PRIME Program sponsors an internship opportunity for a collegiate female majoring in business or finance to work closely with the investment team at Penn Capital. The Intern will learn from portfolio managers, investment analysts, and traders to gain valuable in-depth work experience. Candidates will be selected from local colleges and universities.

The PRIME Program Scholarship

The PRIME Program sponsors a scholarship to Valley Forge Military Academy and College for a female recipient majoring in business or finance. An annual fundraising event is held to benefit the scholarship.

Why PRIME?

Support is Crucial...

- Only 36% of girls age 11-17 understand what it means to invest money
- 90% of girls age 11-17 believe it is important for them to learn about money management

Women are Qualified...

- Women earn almost 60% of undergraduate degrees, and 60% of all master's degrees
- Women are 47% of the US labor force, and 59% of the college-educated, entry-level labor force

But Women are Underrepresented...

- In S&P 500 companies in the Financial Services industry:
 - Over 54% of the workforce are women
 - Only 19% of board directors are women
 - Only 2% of CEOs are women
- In Fortune 500 companies:
 - Only 15% of executive officers, 8% of top earners, and 5% of the CEOs are women
 - Only 17% of board members are women
